All bikes not claimed after 30 days from the date of this posting will be released to MSU Salvage, the MSU Bike Project for sale. Date of Posting April 21, 2025

To retrieve impounded bicycles owners should fill out the form found here: <https://parking.msu.edu/parking-violations/impounded-bikes>. Owners must provide proof of ownership, register the bicycle, and pay the impound fee before the bike will be released. Locks will not be replaced.

This list will be posted at [www.parking.msu.edu](http://www.parking.msu.edu), University Village Community Center, the Union, International Center, Student Services, and MSU Police lobby. This list will provide the make, color and location that each bicycle was impounded from. Once this list is published owners have thirty days to retrieve their bicycle. Bicycles that are not retrieved will be donated to MSU Salvage, the MSU Bike Store, or depending on the severity of disrepair may be disposed of.
